

AN ORDINANCE, granting to CONSUMERS POWER COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right, power and authority to lay, maintain and operate gas mains, pipes and services on, along, across and under the highways, streets, alleys, bridges and other public places, and to do a local gas business in the CITY OF BANGOR, VAN BUREN COUNTY, MICHIGAN for a period of thirty years.

THE CITY OF BANGOR, VAN BUREN COUNTY, MICHIGAN ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. <u>GRANT TERM</u>. The City of Bangor, Van Buren County, Michigan, hereby grants to the Consumers Power Company, a Michigan corporation, its successors and assigns, hereinafter called the "Grantee," the right, power and authority to lay, maintain and operate gas mains, pipes and services on, along, across and under the highways, streets, alleys, bridges and other public places, and to do a local gas business in the City of Bangor, Van Buren County, Michigan for a period of thirty years.

SECTION 2. <u>CONSIDERATION</u>. In consideration of the rights, power and authority hereby granted, said Grantee shall faithfully perform all things required by the terms hereof.

SECTION 3. <u>CONDITIONS</u>. No highway, street, alley, bridge or other public place used by said Grantee shall be obstructed longer than necessary during the work of construction or repair, and shall be restored to the same order and condition as when said work was commenced. All of Grantee's pipes and mains shall be so placed in the highways and other public places as not to unnecessarily interfere with the use thereof for highway purposes.

SECTION 4. <u>HOLD HARMLESS</u>. Said Grantee shall at all times keep and save the City free and harmless from all loss, costs and expense to which it may be subject by reason of the negligent construction and maintenance of the structures and equipment hereby authorized. In case any action is commenced against the City on account of the permission herein given, said Grantee shall, upon notice, defend the City and save it free and harmless from all loss, cost and damage arising out of such negligent construction and maintenance.

SECTION 5. <u>EXTENSIONS</u>. Said Grantee shall construct and extend its gas distribution system within said City, and shall furnish gas to applicants residing therein in accordance with applicable laws, rules and regulations.

SECTION 6. <u>FRANCHISE NOT EXCLUSIVE</u>. The rights, power and authority herein granted, are not exclusive. Either manufactured or natural gas may be furnished hereunder.

SECTION 7. <u>RATES</u>. Said Grantee shall be entitled to charge the inhabitants of said City for gas furnished therein, the rates as approved by the Michigan Public Service Commission, to which Commission or its successors authority and jurisdiction to fix and regulate gas rates and rules regulating such service in said City, as hereby granted for the term of this franchise. Such rates and rules shall be subject to review and change at any time upon petition therefor being made by either said City, acting by its City Council, or by said Grantee.

SECTION 8. <u>REVOCATION</u>. The franchise granted by this ordinance is subject to revocation upon sixty (60) days written notice by the party desiring such revocation.

SECTION 9. MICHIGAN PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION, JURISDICTION. Said Grantee shall, as to all other conditions and elements of service not herein fixed, be and remain subject to the reasonable rules and regulations of the Michigan Public Service Commission or its successors, applicable to gas service in said City.

SECTION 10. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect upon the <u>APRIL 11, 1991</u>, provided however, it shall cease and be of no effect after thirty days from its adoption unless within said period the Grantee shall accept the same in writing filed with the City Clerk. Upon acceptance and publication hereof, this ordinance shall constitute a contract between said City and said Grantee.



Recap of the last 3 months for community engagement and relations.

The Bangor Police Department hosted over 60 kids from the community at the Bangor Police Department. Police Officers gave the children tours of the police department, permitted them to see and inspect police equipment, and allowed them to sit in the police cruisers and to activate the lights and sirens. It was a great turnout and allowed the kids to interact with the police officers.

Bangor Police Department's SRO participated in the school's summer school program. SRO Leonard provided hands on teaching and training in the classroom to nearly 30 students and teachers about communicating with dispatch during an emergency. SRO Leonard developed practical scenarios where kids and teachers were able to participate in mock drills calling dispatch and reporting emergencies. It was a fun learning experience for the kids and teachers.

The Bangor Police Department and Officer Kendregan were recently recognized by Van Buren County's Domestic Violence Coalition for outstanding commitment and dedication to domestic violence victims and survivors. The only police department to receive such an award in Van Buren County.

Bangor Police Department's Officer Nelson was just recently recognized for his community engagement. Ofc Nelson was speaking with a resident who was delinquent to the city. The resident explained they did not have transportation to get to City Hall. Ofc Nelson willingly helped assist the resident to city hall by providing them with a ride, which allowed them to take care of their delinquencies. Officer Nelson then assisted the resident with getting back home.

The Bangor Police Department has reserved a booth for the August 21st back to school bash to engage with the youth, teachers, and other community members at the annual school event.

The Bangor Police Department is one of the few police departments in Van Buren County that have maintained 24-hour coverage to their jurisdiction. There is a mass shortage of police officers in the State of Michigan and across the country. The Bangor Police Department is short, one full-time patrol officer position. However, due to the commitment, professionalism, and retention of the current employees, the Bangor Police Department has maintained around the clock coverage to the City of Bangor to serve the residents.

There are 11 police agencies within Van Buren County. That includes the Sheriff's Department, Michigan State Police, and the Pokagon Tribal Police. The Bangor Police Department is one of 5 out of the 11 agencies who has been able to maintain 24hr coverage. Even the Michigan State Police in Van Buren County are not providing 24hr coverage due to officer shortages.



New Committee Meeting date sheets and new committee member information sheets were given out.


The quotes were formally presented for the brick restoration and placement around the cannon.

Crossing System

I am recommending the city invests in a Traffic Safety Corp pedestrian/student crossing system for the intersection of Arlington St and Alexander St. That intersection is a high pedestrian and student crossing area. The crossing system would make the intersection safer for students and pedestrians crossing the street. The crossing system is a cost-effective and reliable alternative to employing crossing guards. The crossing system is compliant with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices which defines the nationwide standards to install and maintain traffic control devices. Funds for the crossing system can be divided between the Major Street Fund (\$3,685.28) and the Local Street Fund (\$3,685.28) for a total of \$7,370.56.
